Rockland Precision, LLC will not tolerate any kind of unsafe acts, childish behavior, disrespect to the facility/property. As a member it will be expected of you to take care of the facility while you are using it and to leave it as you found it. Once you become a member it now becomes "our" facility and we will need everyone's help to maintain it and keep it enjoyable for all.

MEMBERHSIP INFORMATION:

Any citizen of the United States 18 years of age or older can apply to become a member of Rockland Precision, LLC. It is our goal to build a membership base filled with men/women of high character and regard for the outdoors and shooting sports. By becoming a member, you will have access to the 1000 yard main range to use at your leisure. Please refer to events page on our website for a complete schedule of events and range closures. Please submit your membership application and signed waiver agreement. Upon approval payment for the membership will have to be made in full prior to access being granted to the range. Membership term runs from January 1 through December 31. Membership cards will be given to new members upon approval of membership.

Note: Depending on shooting experience you may be required to attend a range orientation and safety training before being granted access to the range. All membership applications will be reviewed by range director. After application review is complete you will be contacted by the range director with approval/disapproval. Range orientations and safety trainings will be held as needed and TBD.

RANGE RULES (to be followed by everyone while using the range):

Before completing and submitting the membership application please read all range rules, signing the application acknowledges and the range rules and that they will be followed by member and all guests that use the facility.

- SAFETY is the number priority for all while enjoying the range. Any unsafe acts will not be tolerated and grounds for immediate membership dismissal.
- Any issues at all with the range or facility will be brought to immediate attention of Ken or Mark. We want this to be an enjoyable experience for all and if there's any issues or ideas for improvement please don't hesitate to contact us. It's impossible for us to be at the range all the time. You as a member have the responsibility to help maintain and keep our range a safe place.
- Range hours are from sunrise to sunset 7 days a week.
- Rockland Precision, LLC is a "COLD RANGE" this means all firearms should be kept in a safe and unloaded manner until on the firing line. Pistols can be loaded and remain hot while in the pistol bay area. Upon leaving the pistol bay area pistols shall be cleared and slide locked back in the open position.
- Sign in and out of range is required by all members and guests.
- All federal, state, and local firearm laws must be obeyed.
- Guests are only allowed with a member that's in good standing. (Maximum of 2 guests allowed with member) Guests fees for daily usage will be \$30.
- Members must have their membership cards at all times while on the property.
- The range entrance gate can be left open upon entering the facility but must be closed and locked when leaving. If you are unsure if there are other members on the property, always lock the gate to make sure the property is never left open.
- When using the range, firing from the firing line only. Firing from other locations or positions will not be tolerated and will be grounds for membership dismissal.
- Before going downrange to hang paper targets or paint steel, all downrange warning lights must be turned on and all weapons on firing line must be pulled off the line and unloaded, this is for your safety while downrange.
- Only the one who turned on the downrange warning lights can turn the lights off after returning from the firing line after he/she has confirmed there is no one else down range. At this time the range can go hot again and shooting can begin.
- Shooting at any thing other than paper or steel targets is prohibited. Animals, rocks, trees are not targets shooting at this will not be tolerated.
- Shooting of exploding targets is prohibited; this includes tannerite.
- Shooting of .50 BMG is by approval by range director only. Not all targets are rated for .50 BMG
- Shooting carbines with high velocity FMJ or armor piercing ammo is prohibited inside 300 yards.
- Eye protection and ear protection is required for all shooters while on the firing line.
- Shooters are required to bring their own white paint for painting the targets. When spray cans are empty take them with you when you leave the range.
- All garbage should be properly disposed of by you when you leave the range. Garbage disposal is not provided at the range.
- Smoking on firing line is prohibited. Please smoke back behind the firing line and properly dispose of cigarette butts.

- Alcohol and drug use is prohibited while on firing line or participating in any shooting events. If you are found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs you will be asked to leave the premises and to never return.
- Camping may be permitted by range director, please seek prior approval before camping onsite.
- Any members under the age of 18 must be accompanied and under the supervision of an adult at all times.
- Firearm and ammunition sales while at facility is prohibited.
- The range may be closed to members when training or matches are being held. Please follow the website events page or the Rockland Precision facebook page for the most up to date event and closings.
- During the regular archery hunting season, bear rifle season, and deer rifle season the range WILL BE CLOSED to all members during normal hunting times. The range will only be open for use on Sundays during this time.
